
COMES NOW Union Electric Company (d/b/a AmerenUE), by counsel, and
withdraws its Request for Confidential Treatment of Certain Data Contained in FERC
Form No. 1: Annual Report of Major Electric Utilities, Licensees, and Others, and
requests leave to dismiss such Request.

On June 26, 2002, the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) issued a
letter order denying the request of AmerenUE for confidential treatment of portions of its
FERC Form 1 report. Prior to that time, AmerenUE requested in the instant proceeding
that the Missouri Public Service Commission (the "Commission") grant confidential
treatment of similar information filed with it in Missouri. Since the FERC has denied the
request of AmerenUE, its request before the Commission is now moot. Due to an
oversight, AmerenUE was not able to bring this to the Commission's attention until now.

WHEREFORE, AmerenUE requests that the Commission dismiss this matter.


