ORDER ESTABLISHING PROTECTIVE ORDER

On September 21, 2006, the Commission received an application for a certificate of service authority to provide resold basic telecommunications services from Pelzer Communications Corporation. Exhibit IV of the application, which includes Pelzer's financial statements as required by 4 CSR 240-3.510(1)(D), was filed separately with a motion for a protective order.

The Commission finds that there is a need to protect confidential information, and the request for a protective order to maintain the confidentiality of Pelzer's financial statements is reasonable. The Commission has previously recognized the need to protect confidential information, and protective orders have helped minimize disputes in past cases. Therefore, the Commission concludes that a protective order should be granted.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The Motion for Protective Order filed by Pelzer Communications Corporation is granted, and the protective order attached to this order as Attachment A is adopted.

2. This order shall become effective on September 26, 2006.
