STAFF RECOMMENDATION

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) and for its recommendation states:

1. In the attached Memorandum, labeled Appendix A, the Staff recommends that the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission) grant Globetel, Inc. (Applicant) the requested certificate to provide basic local exchange telecommunications service in the service area of Southwestern Bell Telephone L.P. d/b/a/ AT&T Missouri, conditioned upon certain access rate provisions. The Commission shall grant an application for a certificate of telecommunications service authority upon a finding that the grant of authority is in the public interest. Sections 392.430, 392.440 and 392.450 RSMo. (2000).

2. Staff also recommends that the Commission grant Applicant's request for a certificate of service authority to provide local exchange telecommunications services. Local exchange authority should be restricted to dedicated, private line (non-switch) services. The Commission shall grant an application for a certificate of telecommunications service authority upon a finding that the grant of authority is in the public interest. Sections 392.430 and 392.440 RSMo (2000).

3. Staff further recommends that the Commission classify the Applicant and its services as competitive. The Commission may classify a telecommunications provider or its services as competitive if the Commission determines it is “subject to sufficient competition to justify a lesser degree of regulation.” Section 392.361.2 RSMo (2000). All services provided by a competitive company must be classified as competitive. Section 362.361.3 RSMo (2000).

4. Staff recommends that the Commission approve the waivers listed in the Notice of Applications. The Commission may waive the application of its rules and certain statutes if the Commission determines that waiver is consistent with the purposes of Chapter 392. Sections 392.185, 392.361.5 and 392.420.

5. Staff does not object to Applicant’s tariff taking effect January 5, 2007.

WHEREFORE, Staff recommends that the Commission grant Applicant a certificate to provide local exchange telecommunications services restricted to dedicated, private line services and grant Applicant a certificate to provide basic local exchange telecommunications services throughout all exchanges served by AT&T Missouri, contingent upon the listed conditions; and approve the waivers listed in the Notice of Applications. Staff further recommends that the Commission approve Applicant’s tariff effective January 5, 2007.
