NOTICE OPENING CASE

On April 20, 2005, Alma Telephone Company filed its petition for arbitration with the Commission pursuant to the Telecommunications Act of 1996.¹ The petition asks the Commission to arbitrate its unresolved issues with United States Cellular Corporation.

On June 2, Alma Telephone filed a negotiated interconnection agreement in Case No. TO-2005-0374. The filing of the negotiated agreement effectively ends the arbitration.

The Commission opens the case to approve or reject the negotiated interconnection agreement as provided by Section 252(e)(1) of the Telecommunications

¹ In a separate order, the Commission consolidated five other arbitration petitions against U.S. Cellular into Case No. TO-2005-0374. Each of the petitioners has filed negotiated agreements. The Commission will open a new case for each negotiated agreement.

Act of 1996. The negotiated agreement will now appear in this case. All future filings regarding the negotiated agreement shall be filed in this case.
