NOTICE ACKNOWLEDGING VOLUNTARY DISMISSAL OF COMPLAINT
AND CLOSING CASE

Issue Date: July 12, 2007

Michael Ziehmer filed a formal complaint against Union Electric Company d/b/a AmerenUE ("AmerenUE") on June 7, 2007. On June 19, 2007, the Commission notified AmerenUE of the complaint and allowed it thirty days in which to answer as provided by 4 CSR 240-2.070(7). On July 11, 2007, Mr. Ziehmer filed a Notice of Dismissal ("Notice"), in which he informed the Commission that he wished to dismiss his complaint in its entirety since he had reached an agreement with AmerenUE resolving his dispute with the company. The notice also indicates that all parties of record have been served with a copy of the Notice.

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.116(1) permits a complainant to voluntarily dismiss his complaint without an order of the Commission "at any time before prepared testimony has been filed or oral evidence has been offered, by filing a notice of dismissal with the commission and serving a copy on all parties."

No prepared testimony or oral evidence has been offered in this case, and the Notice has been filed with the Commission and served on all parties. Therefore, the Commission acknowledges that Michael Ziehmer has voluntarily dismissed his complaint against Union Electric Company d/b/a AmerenUE. Nothing remains for decision by the Commission and this case may be closed.
