## NOTICE ACKNOWLEDGING DISMISSAL OF COMPLAINT AND CLOSING CASE

Issue Date: May 3, 2012

On March 26, 2012, Donna L. Reseck and On the Line, L.L.C. ("Complainants") filed a formal complaint against Union Electric d/b/a Ameren Missouri. On May 1, 2012, prior to the filing of any testimony or the admission of any evidence, Complainants filed a voluntary dismissal with prejudice pursuant to Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.116(1). Complainants served a copy of its dismissal on all parties.

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.116(1) provides:

An applicant or complainant may voluntarily dismiss an application or complaint without an order of the commission at any time before prepared testimony has been filed or oral evidence has been offered by filing a notice of dismissal with the commission. Once evidence has been offered or prepared testimony filed, an applicant or complainant may dismiss an action only by leave of the commission, or by written consent of the adverse parties.

Complainants' filing is in compliance with the Commission's rule. Therefore, the Commission acknowledges that Donna L. Reseck and On the Line, L.L.C. have voluntarily dismissed their complaint with prejudice. Nothing remains for decision by the Commission

and this file shall be closed.
