ORDER MODIFYING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

Issue Date: July 1, 2013

Effective Date: July 1, 2013

On June 28, 2013, the complainants, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri, and The Empire District Electric Company jointly filed a motion asking the Commission to modify the procedural schedule for this case. The motion explains that the movants have agreed the Commission should address certain legal issues before determining whether any factual issues need to be resolved through an evidentiary hearing. To that end, the movants ask the Commission to suspend the balance of the procedural schedule, including the hearing set for September 19 and 20, 2013, and instead establish a schedule for ruling on dispositive motions regarding the legal issues. The Staff of the Commission, the Office of the Public Counsel, and Missouri Industrial Energy Consumers did not join in the motion, but the motion represents that they have been consulted and do not object to the proposed modification of the procedural schedule.

The Commission will modify the procedural schedule as requested.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:


1. The procedural schedule is modified to provide as follows:

Deadline for parties to file dispositive motions	-	July 23, 2013
Answers to dispositive motions	-	August 16, 2013
Replies to answers to dispositive motions	-	August 30, 2013
Oral argument regarding Dispositive motions	-	September 12, 2013, beginning at 10:00 a.m. Room 310

2. All other events established in the procedural schedule, including the hearing set for September 19 and 20, 2013, are cancelled, but may be rescheduled as needed by subsequent order of the Commission.

3. This order shall become effective upon issuance.
