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1 JUDGE WOODRUFF: All right. Well, welcome,
2 everyone this afternoon for a prehearing conference in File
3 Number EC-2015-0309. This is Staff's complaint against Kansas
4 City Power & Light Company and KCP&L Greater Missouri
5 Operations Company.

7 in KCP&L and GMO.

22 JUDGE WOODRUFF: Okay. Well, I brought you here
23 today so that you can discuss how we want to proceed in this
24 case. I'll ask you to give me a proposed procedural schedule
25 by the end of next week. That will be July 24th. Again, as

1 usual, if you can't agree on a schedule, give me competing
2 schedules, and the Commission will sort it out.

3 In looking at the case, I wasn't sure if there are
4 actually any facts in dispute or if this is something that we
5 need to present to the Commission on the particular set of
6 facts and decide what the regulations and so forth mean. I'll
7 let you consider that as you -- as you discuss it here, and let
8 the Commission decide what's presented to us.

9 So anything else today anyone wants to bring up
10 while we're on the record?

11 Okay. Well, then, with that, then the on-record
12 portion of this proceeding is adjourned. And I'll leave you to
13 your discussions.
