ORDER GRANTING APPLICATIONS TO INTERVENE

On January 23, 2008, Kansas City Power & Light Company applied for a waiver or variance regarding the rates it may charge certain all-electric and electric heating customers. In response, the Commission issued notice of the filing and established February 13 as an intervention deadline. Missouri Gas Energy, an operating division of Southern Union Company, and Trigen-Kansas City Energy Corporation separately applied to intervene on February 13. More than ten days have passed and no party has objected to either application to intervene.

The Commission finds that the interests of MGE and Trigen differ from those of the general public and that their interests may be adversely affected by a final order arising from this case. Furthermore, the Commission finds that allowing MGE and Trigen to intervene will serve the public interest. Therefore, in accordance with Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.075(4), the Commission will grant their applications to intervene.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

- 1. Missouri Gas Energy's Application to Intervene is granted.
- 2. Trigen-Kansas City Energy Corporation's Application to Intervene is granted.
