**ORDER DIRECTING COMPLAINANT  
TO FILE A STATEMENT**

Peter B. Howard filed a complaint against Ameren Missouri and the company filed its answer. The Commission held a prehearing conference at which Complainant pointed out that his primary concern was whether he requested electric service at a certain address be put in his name. The company agreed to provide Complainant with evidence of his request.

Complainant provided e-mails to the parties and to the judge stating that, although remotely close to his accepting responsibility for service at the relevant address, he received the sought after information. He then went on to state that he would contest the information at a later date.

The Commission is unable to determine from Complainant's response whether he intends to pursue his complaint under this file number or whether his concerns have been satisfied. The Commission will therefore direct Complainant to file a statement in this docket stating the same.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. Peter B. Howard shall file a statement, no later than January 31, 2014, informing the Commission of whether his concerns have been satisfied or whether he wishes to proceed toward an evidentiary hearing.
2. This order shall become effective upon issuance.
