14	A.	I will provide a portion of Staff's response to Commissioner Rupp's Order
15	Regarding In	clining Block Rate Proposals. This Order included a request for information about
16	advanced me	tering infrastructure ("AMI") which is the topic my testimony addresses.
17	Q.	What is the specific request that you are addressing?
18	A.	The Order stated "Staff shall provide testimony comparing: Ameren
19	Missouri's c	urrent roll-out of advanced metering infrastructure (AMI) to Evergy Metro's and
20	Evergy Wes	t's roll-out of AMI meters in their respective service territories at the time
21	the Commiss	ion approved their current inclining block rate in File ER-2018-0145 and
22	ER-2018-014	46, respectively."
23	Q.	And what is your response?

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A. The Commission approved the current tariffs implementing inclining block rates for residential summer usage in Case Nos. ER-2018-0145 and ER-2018-0146 on December 6, 2018. KCPL had already installed AMI meters for over 90% of its Missouri customers by December 31, 2015 (Customers in the Kansas City metro area). Approximately 15,000 KCPL customers located in Saline, Chariton, Carroll, Lafayette, Howard, and Pettis Counties did not get AMI meters initially. By September 2016, approximately 180,000 GMO customers, which equates to approximately 56% of GMO's customers, had AMI installed.² GMO planned to install approximately 140,000 additional units in its rural service areas by the end of 2019.³

In contrast, Ameren Missouri expects to install its first AMI meter in July 2020 (approximately one year after it filed the current case) with deployment of approximately 1.3 million AMI meters taking place over a period of years from 2020 to 2025.⁴ The table below lists end of year targets planned by Ameren Missouri:⁵
