ORDER AND NOTICE

On April 15, 2005, Union Electric Company d/b/a AmerenUE filed an Application requesting that the Commission allow it to sell a transformer to Behnen's Container Service.

The Commission has determined that the information officer of the Commission will make notice of this application available to the newspapers and other media serving AmerenUE's service territory, and to all members of the Missouri General Assembly representing those counties. Further, the Data Center of the Commission shall serve a copy of this order on the County Commissioners of the counties in AmerenUE's service territory.

Proper persons wishing to intervene shall have 20 days from the date of this order to file an application to intervene with the Secretary of the Commission and shall send a copy of the application to intervene to all parties as directed below.

1. That the Data Center shall send a copy of this order to the County Commissions in the service territory of Union Electric Company d/b/a AmerenUE.

2. That the Information Officer of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall send notice to the members of the General Assembly representing the service territory of Union Electric Company d/b/a AmerenUE and to the newspapers and other media that serve that service territory.
