Thank you for submitting your 2008 Annual Report to the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission). As a result of my review, I have identified the following item(s) that are not in compliance with Chapter 3 of 4 CSR 240 for Nonpublic Treatment of the Annual Report, and which need(s) to be corrected:

1. An affidavit was not provided.
2. Every page of the report containing non-public information should be clearly marked as redacted on the public version and with asterisk on each HC item. Details on how to do this are in the instructions for how to fill out the annual reports.

The guidelines for submitting a confidential annual report are outlined in the instructions of the report form, as well as its cover letter, which was sent to the company contact provided to the Commission.
