
PETITION OF ARTHUR PERRY BRUDER

COMES NOW, Arthur Perry Bruder, Esq., and, pursuant to 4 CSR 240-2.030, submits this petition for leave to appear *pro hac vice* before the Public Service Commission of the State of Missouri (the "Commission") as an attorney for the United States Department of Energy ("DOE"), the United States National Nuclear Administration ("NNSA") and all other affected Federal Executive Agencies ("FEA") (collectively "DOE/NNSA"). In support of this petition, Mr. Bruder states as follows:

1. I am an attorney who is not admitted to practice before the courts of the State of Missouri but is admitted to practice before the courts of the State of New York. I am a member of the New York Bar in good standing and am not under suspension or disbarment by any of the courts of New York. I have been in active practice of law since 1970.
2. I am an employee of the Office of General Counsel of the United States Department of Energy.
3. Attached hereto is the receipt of the Clerk of the Supreme Court of the State of Missouri acknowledging receipt of \$100, as per that Court's Rule 601(m) for me to appear in this proceeding.
4. On March 13, 2007, this Commission entered an order granting DOE/NNSA intervention in this proceeding.
5. I hereby designate Mark M. Comley, of the firm of Newman, Comley & Ruth P.C., a member in good standing of the Bar of the State of Missouri, who has entered his appearance herein, as local representative for DOE/NNSA.


