ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR PROTECTIVE ORDER

This order grants the request for the Commission's standard protective order.

Access One, Inc., filed an application for authority to provide resold basic local exchange telecommunications services on March 16, 2006. On the same date, the company filed a Motion for Protective Order. Access One requested that proprietary financial information that it intends to file in support of its application be subject to a protective order. Specifically, protection is requested for financial statements for Access One, a privately held company that is not subject to public reporting requirements. The motion states that the information to be protected is not known outside of Access One and that disclosure of the information would cause material damage to the company's competitive and financial position, in that it would provide the company's competitors with sensitive data respecting Access One's sales, customer usage, and financing strategies.

Upon review of the company's motion, the Commission finds that there is a need to protect confidential information and the request for a protective order is reasonable. The Commission has previously recognized the need to protect confidential information, and the

issuance of protective orders has helped to minimize disputes in past cases. Therefore, the Commission concludes that a protective order shall be granted.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

- 1. The Motion for Protective Order filed by Access One, Inc., on March 16, 2006, is granted, and the protective order attached to this order (Attachment A) adopted.
