- (53) "Telecommunications service", the transmission of information by wire, radio, optical cable, el impulses, or other similar means. As used in this definition, "information" means knowledge or inte represented by any form of writing, signs, signals, pictures, sounds, or any other symbols. Telecommun service does not include:
- (a) The rent, sale, lease, or exchange for other value received of customer premises equipment ex customer premises equipment owned by a telephone company certificated or otherwise authorized to telephone service prior to September 28, 1987, and provided under tariff or in inventory on January 1, 198: must be detariffed no later than December 31, 1987, and thereafter the provision of which shall n telecommunications service, and except for customer premises equipment owned or provided telecommunications company and used for answering 911 or emergency calls;
- (b) Answering services and paging services;
- (c) The offering of radio communication services and facilities when such services and facilities are p under a license granted by the Federal Communications Commission under the commercial mobile radio: rules and regulations;
- (d) Services provided by a hospital, hotel, motel, or other similar business whose principal service is the p of temporary lodging through the owning or operating of message switching or billing equipment solely purpose of providing at a charge telecommunications services to its temporary patients or guests;
- (e) Services provided by a private telecommunications system;
- (f) Cable television service;
- (g) The installation and maintenance of inside wire within a customer's premises;
- (h) Electronic publishing services; or
- (i) Services provided pursuant to a broadcast radio or television license issued by the Federal Commun. Commission;
