ORDER ESTABLISHING TIME FOR RESPONSE

On June 22, 2006, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed a motion requesting that the Commission establish a case, provide notice, set an intervention deadline and schedule an early prehearing conference for the purpose of establishing a record of consideration and a determination as to whether to adopt the Time-Based Metering and Communications Standard established in Section 1252 of the Energy Policy Act of 2005 ("EPAAct"). The Commission granted Staff's motion on June 23, 2006, and the intervention deadline was set for July 24, 2006.

The deadline for interventions has now passed. Because the prehearing in this matter is scheduled for August 4, 2006, it would benefit the Commission to rule on any pending motion to intervene expeditiously. Consequently, the Commission will set an early date for any party to oppose any pending motions to intervene.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. Any party wishing to oppose any pending motions to intervene shall do so no later than August 1, 2006.

2. This order shall become effective on July 25, 2006.
