**ORDER DIRECTING NOTICE OF TAX IMPACT**

On August 20, 2007, Aquila, Inc., d/b/a Aquila Networks – MPS and Aquila Networks – L&P (“Aquila”) filed an application with the Missouri Public Service Commission for authority to transfer operational control of certain transmission assets to the Midwest Independent Transmission System Operator, Inc. Aquila states that because this transaction does not necessitate any transfer of title, there will be no tax impact on the revenues of the counties in which Aquila serves.

In accordance with Section 393.190.1, RSMo 2000, the Commission directs its Data Center to send a copy of this notice to the county clerk of each county located within Aquila’s service territory.

**IT IS ORDERED THAT:**

1. The Data Center of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall send a copy of this notice to the clerks of the counties described in the body of this order.

2. This order shall become effective on August 28, 2007.
