ORDER DIRECTING STAFF TO ADVISE COMMISSION IF NEW TARIFF FILINGS ARE IN COMPLIANCE WITH REPORT AND ORDER

On July 12, 2007,¹ the Missouri Public Service Commission issued its Report and Order in this matter. In the Report and Order, the Commission, *inter alia*, directed all Missouri Public Service Commission regulated electric utilities to file with the Commission revised tariffs to specifically identify compliance with IEEE 1547 as a criterion for approval of customer interconnection of a distributed generation source. On July 23, Empire filed its revised tariff sheet bearing an effective date of August 22 (tariff tracking number YE-2008-0052).

The Commission will direct its Staff to file a recommendation advising the Commission whether the revised tariff sheet is in compliance with the Commission's July 12, Report and Order.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall file a recommendation advising the Commission whether The Empire District Electric Company's revised tariff sheet, filed on July 23, 2007 (tariff tracking number

YE-2008-0052) is in compliance with the Commission's July 12, 2007 Report and Order in this matter.

2. The Staff of the Commission shall file the pleading described in ordered paragraph 1 no later than August 10, 2007.

3. This order shall become effective on July 24, 2007.
