ORDER DIRECTING STAFF TO FILE A RECOMMENDATION

On March 24, 2008, AGL Networks, LLC (“AGLN”) filed an application for a certificate of service authority to provide intrastate interexchange and non-switched local exchange telecommunications services in Missouri. AGLN also requested to be classified as a competitive company with the standard waivers.

AGLN's application did not (and was not required to) contain a proposed tariff.¹ The Commission issued notice and established April 17, 2008 as the deadline for submission of requests to intervene. No one has asked to intervene.

The Commission will direct its Staff to file a recommendation before acting on AGLN's application.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The Staff of the Commission shall, by no later than 5:00 p.m. on Friday, May 23, 2008, file its recommendation regarding the application of AGL Networks, LLC.
