STAFF RECOMMENDATION

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission and for its recommendation, states as follows:

- 1. On September 18, 2009, Cincinnati Bell Any Distance Inc. ("the Company") filed its Application in this case. It requested the authority to provide basic local telecommunications and non-switched local exchange telecommunications service in the State of Missouri, classify the company and its basic local services as competitive. In that Application, the Company noted that it is a publicly traded company whose financial documents are open to the public on the Securities and Exchange Commission's web site (and the application included a link to those documents). The Company sought a waiver of 4 CSR 240-3.510(1)(D)1.B-D, which the Staff supported but on which the Commission has yet to act.
- 2. In the attached Memorandum, labeled Appendix A, the Staff recommends that the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission) grant Applicant a certificate to provide basic local telecommunications and non-switched local exchange telecommunications service. The Commission shall grant an application for a certificate of telecommunications service authority upon a finding that the grant of authority is in the public interest. §§392.430 and 392.440 RSMo (2000).
- 3. Staff also recommends that the Commission classify the Applicant and the services it proposes to offer in its Application as competitive. The Commission may classify a telecommunications provider or its services as competitive if the Commission determines it is subject to sufficient competition to justify a lesser degree of regulation and that such lesser regulation is consistent with the protection of ratepayers and promotes public interest. §392.361.4. (2008). A majority of the services a competitive company provides must be classified as competitive. §392.361.3. (2008).

- 4. Staff notes that a tariff was not submitted with the application; the Company may not provide telecommunications services in Missouri without an approved tariff. Any waivers sought by the Company other than that mentioned in Paragraph 1 above should be considered when the tariff is filed, in which the requested or elected waivers are listed.
- 5. The Staff further recommends that the Commission state in its order that, pursuant to Section 392.410, the authority conferred by the certificate of service authority shall be null and void unless it is exercised within one year of its issuance.
- 6. The Applicant is not delinquent in filing an annual report, paying the PSC assessment, MoUSF, and Relay Missouri.
 - 7. The Staff recommends that the application be granted with the following conditions:
 - a. The applicant's originating and terminating access rates shall not exceed the access rates of the incumbent local exchange company against whom the applicant is competing pursuant to Sections 392.361.6 and 392.370 RSMo.
 - b. If the directly competing ILEC, in whose service area the applicant is operating, decreases its originating and/or terminating access service rates, the applicant shall file an appropriate tariff amendment to reduce its originating and/or terminating access rates in the directly competing ILEC's service area within 30 days of the directly competing ILEC's reduction of its originating and/or terminating access rates in order to maintain the cap.

WHEREFORE, Staff recommends that the Commission grant Cincinnati Bell Any Distance Inc. a certificate of service authority to provide basic local telecommunications and non-switched local exchange telecommunications service; grant it the requested competitive classification; condition the grant of service authority as described in Paragraph 7 above and order the Company to file its tariffs, which shall include any requested or elected waivers.

Granting a certificate to provide basic local exchange telecommunications services should be based on the following two conditions:

- 1. The applicant's originating and terminating access rates shall not exceed the access rates of the incumbent local exchange company against whom the applicant is competing pursuant to Sections 392.361.6 and 392.370 RSMo.
- 2. If the directly competing ILEC, in whose service area the applicant is operating, decreases its originating and/or terminating access service rates, the applicant shall file an appropriate tariff amendment to reduce its originating and/or terminating access rates in the directly competing ILEC's service area

	within 30 days of the directly competing ILEC's reduction of its originating and/or terminating access rates in order to maintain the cap.
