## NOTICE OF DEFICIENCY



On November 24, 2015, Modern Dial Tone filed an affidavit related to an application for registration to provide interconnected voice over Internet protocol service. Modern Dial Tone failed to file an application with the affidavit. Furthermore, pursuant to 4 CSR 240-2.080(2), pleadings filed with the Commission must be signed by at least one attorney of record authorized to practice law in Missouri. The affidavit is not signed by a Missouri attorney. In addition, the affidavit attached to the application failed to provide the exchanges in which the company proposes to provide VoIP service, pursuant to §392.550.3(2), RSMo.

Modern Dial Tone's filing is deficient and the Commission will not take action on this application until these deficiencies are corrected. The Commission will leave the file open until December 21, 2015, to allow Modern Dial Tone to correct the

deficiencies. If no response is filed by that time, the Commission will reject the application and close the file.
