NOTICE ACKNOWLEDGING DISMISSAL OF APPLICATION AND CLOSING CASE

Issue Date: January 10, 2008

On November 1, 2007, Wholesale Carrier Services, Inc. ("Wholesale") applied for a certificate of service authority to provide basic local exchange telecommunications services within the state of Missouri, and for competitive classification. On January 10, 2008, prior to the filing of any testimony or the admission of any evidence, Wholesale filed a Notice of Dismissal pursuant to Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.116(1).

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.116(1) provides as follows:

(1) An applicant or complainant may voluntarily dismiss an application or complaint without an order of the commission at any time before prepared testimony has been filed or oral evidence has been offered, by filing a notice of dismissal with the commission and serving a copy on all parties. Once evidence has been offered or prepared testimony filed, an applicant or complainant may dismiss an action only by leave of the commission, or by written consent of the adverse parties.

No prepared testimony or oral evidence has been offered in this case. There were no interveners in this matter, and although Wholesale has not included a Certificate of Service demonstrating that the General Counsel's Office or that the Office of the Public Counsel

have been served with a copy of this notice (the only other parties to this action), the Commission will treat Wholesale's Notice, which was filed in the Commission's Electronic Information and Filing System, as having served notice on those parties. Therefore, the Commission acknowledges that Wholesale has voluntarily dismissed its application. Nothing remains for decision by the Commission and this case may be closed.
