## ORDER EXTENDING TIME TO RESPOND TO MOTIONS

On January 23, 2008, Kansas City Power & Light Company applied for a waiver or variance regarding the rates it may charge certain all-electric and electric heating customers. Missouri Gas Energy and Trigen-Kansas City Energy Corporation filed motions to dismiss KCPL's application on April 18. In addition, Staff filed what it called an informational filing on the same date. The procedural schedule for this case provides that responses to those filings are to be made no later than Monday, April 28.

On Friday, April 25, KCPL filed a motion requesting additional time to file its response. KCPL explains that counsel and personnel needed to prepare its response are involved in a hearing before the Commission and need more time to file that response.

KCPL's request for more time is reasonable and will not prejudice any other party.

The Commission will grant the motion for extension of time to respond.

## IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. Kansas City Power & Light Company's motion for extension of time to respond is granted.

- 2. Any party wishing to respond to the dispositive motions filed on April 18, 2008, by Missouri Gas Energy and Trigen-Kansas City Energy Corporation, or the April 18 informational filing of Staff, shall do so no later than May 5, 2008.
  - 3. This order shall become effective on April 25, 2008.
