Dear Mr. Reed:

AT&T Communications of the Southwest, Inc. and AT&T Missouri ("AT&T Companies") by this letter withdraw their Motion to Suspend and Investigate, which the AT&T Companies filed with the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") against Bandwith.com's Access Services Tariff on October 28, 2009.

The AT&T Companies wish to note that withdrawing their motion should not be misconstrued as acquiescence to any charges that may be assessed under this tariff. The AT&T Companies believe that local exchange carriers generally have the right to provide all traditional elements of switched access service and to be compensated for the services provided. However, the AT&T Companies reserve the right to raise as a billing dispute whether a particular element of switched access service, such as local switching, is actually being provided and properly billed, and to bring such issues to the Commission as a complaint if deemed necessary.

We would appreciate your bringing this letter to the Commission's attention. Please let us know if anything further is needed.
