## ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION TO FILE A STATUS REPORT OR RECOMMENDATION

On March 5, 2009<sup>1</sup>, Nancy and Ron Gilkey asked the Commission to allow them to change their electrical supplier from the City of Rich Hill, Missouri to Osage Valley Electric Cooperative. The application included unverified statements from the City of Rich Hill and from Osage Valley Electric Cooperative that claim that the suppliers consent to the change.

The Commission ordered its Staff to file a recommendation no later than April 8. Instead of a recommendation, on April 8, Staff filed a Motion for an Extension to File a Status Report or Recommendation and Renewal of Staff's Motion to Add Parties.<sup>2</sup> Staff explains that it has submitted data requests to the Gilkeys, the answers to which are due April 13. Therefore, Staff asks for an extension until April 29 to file a status report or recommendation.

The Commission finds Staff's request for an extension of time reasonable, and will grant it.
