**ORDER GRANTING ADDITIONAL TIME TO RESPOND TO STAFF'S
RECOMMENDATION TO GRANT APPLICATION WITH CONDITIONS**

Union Electric Company d/b/a AmerenUE has applied for authority to manage its nitrogen oxide emission allowances inventory using any and all available trading structures as outlined in the application. The Commission's Staff filed its recommendation regarding that application on May 19, 2010. Subsequently, the Commission ordered that any party wishing to respond to Staff's recommendation do so no later than June 1.

On May 27, AmerenUE filed a motion asking for an additional 30 days to respond to Staff's recommendation. The motion represents that the other parties to this case, Staff and Public Counsel, do not object to AmerenUE's request for additional time.

AmerenUE's request is reasonable and is not opposed by any party. The Commission will grant that motion.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. AmerenUE's Motion for Additional Time to Respond to Staff's Recommendation is granted.

2. Any party that wishes to respond to Staff's Recommendation to Grant Application with Conditions shall do so no later than July 1, 2010.

3. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
