AMERENUE'S SUGGESTIONS IN SUPPORT OF MOTION FOR ADDITIONAL TIME

COMES NOW Union Electric Company d/b/a AmerenUE (the "Company") and, in support of Southern Union's Motion for Additional Time Within Which to Further Advise the Commission (the "Motion"), states as follows to the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission"):

- 1. The Commission previously issued its Order Granting Intervention and Directing Filing in which, among other things, it directed the parties to this case, jointly or separately, to file a pleading advising the Commission of the procedural posture of this case.
- 2. On June 13, 2003, Southern Union filed its Motion asking that the Commission allow the parties an additional fourteen (14) days, until July 9, 2003, to provide the requested information. Southern Union explained that within that time Southern Union would have definitive information about the state budget ad the related appropriations bills, including additional information about any further "sweeps" of the Public Service Commission Fund.
- AmerenUE supports Southern Union's Motion and suggests that AmerenUE would also be better able to indicate how it believes the applications for rehearing should proceed by July 9, 2003.
