ORDER CANCELING CERTIFICATE

Issue Date: June 24, 2011

Effective Date: July 4, 2011

On May 26, 2011, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed a motion requesting Global Crossing Telemanagement, Inc.'s ("Global") certificate of service authority and accompanying tariff to provide basic local exchange telecommunications services in the State of Missouri be cancelled.

In File Number TA-98-161, the Commission granted Global a certificate of service authority and accompanying tariff to provide basic local exchange telecommunications service in the State of Missouri.

Staff states in its motion that Global filed a request asking that the company's certificate be cancelled. Staff recommends that the Commission cancel the company's certificate of service authority and accompanying tariff to provide basic local exchange telecommunications services.

On June 2, 2011, the Commission issued an Order Directing Notice allowing any parties to file an objection or request a hearing to do so no later than June 13, 2011. No objections or requests for a hearing were filed.

The Commission has the authority to cancel a certificate and tariff pursuant to Section 392.410.5, RSMo, which states, in part, "[a]ny certificate or service authority

may be altered or modified by the commission after notice and hearing, upon its own motion or upon application of the person or company affected.”

The Commission’s records indicate that on December 1, 2010, Global filed replacement tariff sheets, File No. TN-2011-0163. Global indicated an approved merger with Global Crossing Local Services, Inc. would occur on December 31, 2010, as the result of an internal corporate reorganization. The approved tariff sheets of Global Crossing Local Services, Inc., JC-2011-0278, replaced the previous tariff sheets, effective on December 31, 2010. Therefore, the tariff sheets originally approved in TA-98-161 for Global are no longer effective and need not be cancelled in this order.

Based on the company’s request and Staff’s motion, the Commission finds that the certificate of service authority granted to Global Crossing Telemanagement, Inc., shall be canceled.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The certificate of authority to provide basic local exchange telecommunications services granted to Global Crossing Telemanagement, Inc., in File Number TA-98-161, is canceled.
2. This order shall become effective on July 4, 2011.

3. This case may be closed on July 5, 2011.
