**ORDER MODIFYING THE PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE AND  
RESETTING EVIDENTIARY HEARING**

Issue Date: April 1, 2021

Effective Date: April 1, 2021

On March 29, 2021, the Commission issued its order suspending the evidentiary hearing set for April 1, 2021, and ordered the parties to submit a new date for an evidentiary hearing. The parties jointly filed a proposed date for an evidentiary hearing along with a request to reopen discovery. The Commission will adopt the proposed evidentiary hearing date and reopen discovery.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. Any new data requests shall be submitted no later than April 2, 2021. The time to respond to new data requests is shortened to seven days.

2. The parties shall appear for an evidentiary hearing at 9:00 a.m. on April 15, 2021. The evidentiary hearing shall be held by video and teleconference via WebEx. Participants shall appear at the evidentiary hearing telephonically via WebEx video and telephone conference. The hearing will also be live-streamed via the Commission's website at [www.psc.mo.gov](http://www.psc.mo.gov). Interested persons who will not be actively

participating in the hearing should access the hearing via the live stream. The link and access code to participate in the hearing via WebEx conference call will be emailed to all parties.

3. The additional procedural requirements contained in ordered paragraph five of the Commission's January 20, 2021, Order Establishing Procedural Schedule and Other Procedural Requirements, not specifically modified by this order, remain effective.

4. This order shall be effective April 1, 2021.
