NOTICE OF DEFICIENCY

On August 1, 2007, Wasatch Investments, LC, (Wasatch) filed a verified application for a change of electric supplier from Union Electric Company, d/b/a AmerenUE, to Cuivre River Electric. The request appears to be for electric service supplied to a business to be operated by Mr. Ronald L. Fruend at 1665 Kemmar Court, O'Fallon, Missouri 63145.

Although unclear from the face of its change of supplier request, Wasatch Investments appears to be a limited liability company. As such, its application is deficient in that the party signing the application, Ronald L. Fruend, does not appear to be a Missouri-licensed attorney.

To redress this deficiency Wasatch Investments must provide proof of Mr. Fruend's good standing with the Missouri Bar, or else bring its application into compliance with 4 CSR 240-2.040(3)(C), the rule that sets forth who may practice as an attorney before the Commission. If Mr. Fruend is not a licensed Missouri attorney, but is an attorney licensed in another state and wishes to appear before the Commission in this proceeding, he will need to be admitted *pro hac vice* and demonstrate compliance with the Commission's rules and Missouri Supreme Court Rules 6.01(m) and 9.03.

No action will be taken on said change of supplier request until it is brought into compliance with all Commission regulatory requirements. If no action is taken in this case within ninety (90) days it may be dismissed.
