2. As set out in the Jointly Proposed Modification to the Procedural Schedule, objections to a data request submitted to the Midwest Independent Transmission System Operator, Inc., shall be due within five days of service of that data request.

3. As set out in the Jointly Proposed Modification to the Procedural Schedule, the Midwest Independent Transmission System Operator, Inc., shall use its best efforts to respond to data requests within ten to fifteen days of service.

4. This order shall become effective on January 23, 2008.
