ORDER DIRECTING NOTICE AND ESTABLISHING TIME TO RESPOND

On October 25, 2011, Union Electric Company, d/b/a Ameren Missouri, filed a notice of change in its preferred 2011 utility resource plan pursuant to the Commission's Integrated Resource Planning Rules.¹ The Commission's Staff filed a motion on November 9, in which it contends Ameren Missouri's notice of change in its utility resource plan is deficient and asks the Commission to direct Ameren Missouri to cure the alleged deficiency.

The Commission will provide notice of these filings to potentially interested parties and will establish a deadline for the filing of applications to intervene. The Commission will also establish a date for Ameren Missouri and other interested parties to respond to Staff's motion.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Commission's Data Center shall send a copy of this order to each party to File Number EO-2011-0271, the case established to consider Ameren Missouri's 2011 Utility Resource Filing.
2. Applications to intervene shall be filed no later than November 28, 2011.

3. Union Electric Company, d/b/a Ameren Missouri shall respond to Staff's Motion no later than December 2, 2011.

4. Any other party that wishes to respond to Staff's Motion shall do so no later than December 2, 2011.

5. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
