On November 1, 2007, Union Electric Company, d/b/a AmerenUE, filed an application seeking authority to continue the control of its transmission system by the Midwest Independent Transmission System Operator, Inc. (Midwest ISO). The Commission provided notice of the filing to potentially interested parties and established November 30 as an intervention deadline.

Midwest ISO filed an application to intervene on November 6. No party has objected to that application to intervene.
