ORDER GRANTING THE APPLICATION TO INTERVENE OF SOUTHWEST POWER POOL, INC.

On November 1, 2007, Union Electric Company, d/b/a AmerenUE, filed an application seeking authority to continue the control of its transmission system by the Midwest Independent Transmission System Operator, Inc. (Midwest ISO). The Commission provided notice of the filing to potentially interested parties and established November 30 as an intervention deadline.

Southwest Power Pool, Inc., filed an application to intervene on November 21. Southwest Power Pool is a Regional Transmission Organization in which AmerenUE could participate as an alternative to continued participation in the Midwest ISO. No party has objected to Southwest Power Pool's application to intervene.

The Commission finds that the interest of Southwest Power Pool in this case is different from that of the general public, and may be adversely affected by a final order arising from this case. Furthermore, the Commission finds that allowing Southwest Power Pool to intervene will serve the public interest. Therefore, in accordance with 4 CSR 240-2.075(4), the Commission will grant the application to intervene.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

- 1. The Application to Intervene of Southwest Power Pool, Inc., is granted.
- 2. This order shall become effective on December 4, 2007.
