**ORDER GRANTING VARIANCE**

Issue Date: July 22, 2015

Effective Date: August 21, 2015

Under Commission rule 4 CSR 240-22.080(1)(C), Ameren Missouri is required to file its triennial Integrated Resource Plan with the Commission on April 1, 2017. On June 1, 2015, Ameren requested a variance from the rule allowing the company to instead make its filing no later than October 1, 2017. The Commission issued notice of the request and there were no applications to intervene.

In its request, Ameren explains that Chapter 22 rules are closely linked to the process of gaining Commission approval for demand-side management programs under Chapter 20 for implementation of the requirements of the Missouri Energy Efficiency Investment Act. Ameren explains in detail how approval of its request for a variance will result in up-to-date, accurate and consistent results and allow the company to avoid redundant analysis and effort while satisfying both Commission rules.

On July 2, 2015, Staff filed a response stating that it has no objection to Ameren's request.

Under 4 CSR 240-080(13), the Commission may grant a variance for good cause shown. The Commission finds that Ameren has presented good cause for the variance and will grant the requested relief.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. Ameren Missouri's request for variance is granted.
2. This order shall become effective on August 21, 2015.
3. This file shall be closed on August 22, 2015.
