The Missouri Public Service Commission is granting the Motion for Extension of Time and Request to Set an Evidentiary Hearing Date ("the motion").

Jerry and Sharon West initiated this action for a change of electrical supplier ("the application") on November 14, 2008. On May 20, 2009, the Commission's staff ("Staff") filed the motion, representing that all parties, and movant for intervention WIK, L.L.C. ("movant"), agree with the motion. The motion addresses our May 6, 2009 order, which directed the parties to make two filings.

The first filing is a list of disputed issues, which we ordered filed no later than May 22, 2009. The motion asks the Commission to extend the time for filing such list until May 30, 2009. Such an extension, Staff asserts, will help to make the report more accurate, to address the issues of the parties and movant, and to develop a stipulation of facts.

The second filing is a list of conflict dates in June 2009 for setting a hearing on the application. The motion proposes a date, time and location for the hearing. Such setting accommodates the needs of all parties and movant.

Staff has supported each of its requests with efficient and constructive processes for resolving matters related to the application, which furthers the public interest, so the

Commission will grant the motion.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Motion for Extension of Time and Request to Set an Evidentiary Hearing

Date is granted.

2. The time for filing the report identifying disputed issues as described in the

Commission's May 6, 2009, order is extended to May 30, 2009.

3. On June 15, 2009, at 10:00 a.m., the Commission will convene a hearing on

the application in Room 310 of the Governor Office Building, 200 Madison Street,

Jefferson City, Missouri.

4. The hearing room is in a building that meets accessibility standards required
