This order corrects an error in the Order Granting Certificate to Provide Basic Local Telecommunications Services and Approving Tariff (Order), issued on January 27, 2011. NextGen Communications, Inc., requested statewide authority rather than authority to provide service only in the services areas of the three companies listed in the Order, and the Staff of the Commission recommended a grant of statewide authority.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

The second paragraph on page 1 of the Commission's January 27, 2011
Order is corrected so that it reads as follows:

"On August 25, 2010, NextGen Communications, Inc. applied for a certificate of service authority to provide basic local exchange telecommunications services within the state of Missouri, and for competitive classification. The company seeks certification to provide basic local service throughout the state of Missouri. NextGen is authorized to do business in Missouri by the Missouri Secretary of State."

2. Ordered Paragraph 1 on page 5 of the Commission's January 27, 2011

Order is corrected so that it reads as follows:

- "1. NextGen Communications, Inc. is granted a certificate of service authority to provide basic local telecommunications services throughout the state of Missouri, subject to the conditions and recommendations contained in the Staff's Memorandum."
- 3. This order shall become effective on February 5, 2011.
