On February 23, 2011, Union Electric Company, d/b/a Ameren Missouri, filed its 2011 Integrated Resource Plan (IRP), which is required by the Commission's Electric Utility Resource Planning rule, 4 CSR 240-22. The purpose of the IRP is to ensure that investorowned electric utilities, such as Ameren Missouri, consider all options, including demand side efficiency and energy management measures, so as to provide safe, reliable and efficient electric service to the public at reasonable rates, in a manner that serves the public interest.

As required by Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-22.080(4), the Commission will give notice of Ameren Missouri's filing to potentially interested parties, will set a date for the filing of requests to intervene, and will schedule a conference. The Commission has previously added several parties to this case and those parties do not need to again ask to intervene.¹

¹ Those parties are the Missouri Department of Natural Resources, the Missouri Industrial Energy Consumers, the Sierra Club, Missouri Coalition for the Environment, the Missouri Nuclear Weapons Education Fund, operating as Mid-Missouri Peaceworks, the Natural Resources Defense Council, and the Missouri Energy Group.
