Various parties have identified what they contend are deficiencies in Union Electric Company, d/b/a Ameren Missouri's 2011 Utility Resource Plan. On September 16, 2011, the parties filed a jointly proposed procedural schedule by which they ask the Commission to consider the alleged deficiencies. The Commission will adopt the schedule as proposed.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

 - A. Ameren Missouri's Integrated Resource Plan filed February 23, 2011;
 - B. The reports and comments filed June 23, 2011, i.e., the comments of Grain Belt Express Clean Line, LLC; the joint comments and reply of Natural Resources Defense Council, Sierra Club, Renew Missouri, Mid-Missouri Peaceworks, and Great Rivers Environmental Law Center; the comments of the Missouri Department of Natural Resources; the report of the Office of the Public Counsel (as substituted on June 27, 2011, and corrected on July 22, 2011); the Staff Report (as corrected on June 27, 2011);

- C. Ameren Missouri's August 22, 2011 response to the reports and comments (with revised appendix A filed on September 1, 2011).
- 2. The following procedural schedule is established:

Affidavits filed by all parties identifying - individuals responsible as witnesses for comments, portions of reports, and responses for which they are responsible as witnesses

September 19, 2011

Rebuttal testimony filed by all parties (limited to rebutting Ameren Missouri's August 22, 2011 response)

October 28, 2011

Surrebuttal and cross-surrebuttal testimony filed by all parties

November 30, 2011

List and Order of Issues, Order of Witnesses, Order of Cross-Examination, Order of Opening

December 12, 2011

Hearing

December 15 and 16, 2011, beginning at 8:30 a.m.

3. The parties shall comply with the following procedural requirements:

A. All pleadings, briefs, and amendments shall be filed in accordance with Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.080. Briefs shall follow the same list of issues as filed in the case and must set forth and cite the proper portions of the record concerning the remaining unresolved issues that are to be decided by the Commission.

B. All parties shall bring an adequate number of copies of exhibits that they intend to offer into evidence at the hearing. If an exhibit has not been prefiled, the party offering it must bring, in addition to the copy for the court reporter, copies for the five Commissioners, the Presiding Judge, and all counsel.

- 4. The hearing shall be held at the Commission's office at the Governor Office Building, Room 310, 200 Madison Street, Jefferson City, Missouri. This building meets accessibility standards required by the Americans with Disabilities Act.
