CENTRAL JEFFERSON'S STATUS REPORT AND MOTION TO DISMISS

COMES NOW Central Jefferson County Utilities, Inc. (Central Jefferson or Company), and, as its Status Report and Motion to Dismiss, states as follows to the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission):

- 1. On April 11, 2007, the Commission issued an Order Directing Filing in which it pointed out that a transfer of Central Jefferson's system to the Jefferson County Public Sewer District (Sewer District) had been authorized by the Commission in Case No. SO-2007-0071, and that once that transfer has been completed, the Commission would have no jurisdiction over the Sewer District's rates.
- 2. On April 20, 2007, the Commission issued its Order Granting Motion for Continuance wherein it stated that "this case could become moot, depending upon when Central Jefferson finally closes the above-referenced sale to Jefferson County Public Sewer District."
- 3. The transactions authorized by the Commission's Report and Order in Case SO-2007-0071 were completed and the Central Jefferson assets transferred to the Sewer District on June 1, 2007.
- 4. As suggested by the prior Commission orders, this matter is now moot as Central Jefferson no longer owns or operates water or sewer properties.

WHEREFORE, Central Jefferson respectfully requests that the Commission

Consider this Status Report and thereafter dismiss this case.
