STAFF RECOMMENDATION REGARDING KCPL’S COMPLIANCE TARIFF FILING

COMES NOW the Staff (“Staff”) of the Missouri Public Service Commission (“Commission”) and respectfully states as follows:

1. On July 27, 2007, Kansas City Power & Light Company (“KCPL” or “Company”) filed tariff sheets for the purpose of adding “IEEE 1547” to the requirements for Company approval of a customer-generator’s electrical equipment and installation. The tariff sheets bear a proposed effective date of September 1, 2007. The filing was made to comply with ordered paragraph 3 in the Commission’s July 12, 2007 Report And Order, which states in relevant part:

No later than August 1, 2007, all Missouri Public Service Commission regulated electric utilities shall file with the Commission revised tariffs to specifically identify compliance with IEEE 1547 as a criterion for approval of customer interconnection of a distributed generation source.

2. On July 30, 2007, the Commission issued an Order directing the Staff to file by August 20, 2007, a recommendation as to whether KCPL’s filing complies with the aforementioned Report And Order.

3. In the attached Memorandum (Appendix A), the Staff, following its review of KCPL’s filing, recommends that the Commission grant KCPL’s request by approving the following proposed tariff sheets, as filed on July 27, 2007, to become effective on September 1, 2007, or permit the tariff sheets to go into effect by operation of law:

First Revised Sheet No. 34B canceling Original Sheet No. 34B

First Revised Sheet No. 34E canceling Original Sheet No. 34E

WHEREFORE, the Staff respectfully recommends that the Commission issue an order approving the tariff sheets identified herein, to become effective on September 1, 2007, or permit the tariff sheets to go into effect by operation of law.

On July 27, 2007, Kansas City Power & Light Company (KCPL or Company) of Kansas City, Missouri, filed with the Commission two (2) tariff sheets, each bearing a proposed effective date of September 1, 2007, to comply with the Commission's Report And Order issued July 12, 2007 in Case No. EO-2006-0497 (Report And Order). These tariff sheets revise the Company's Net Metering Schedule by adding "IEEE 1547" to the requirements for a customer-generator's electrical equipment and installation.

In its Report And Order, the Commission directed in Ordered 3:

No later than August 1, 2007, all Missouri Public Service Commission regulated electric utilities shall file with the Commission revised tariffs to specifically identify compliance with IEEE 1547 as a criterion for approval of customer interconnection of a distributed generation source.

Staff Recommendation

The Staff has reviewed the filed tariff sheets, and is of the opinion that they were filed in a timely manner and comply with the Commission's Report And Order. The Staff therefore recommends that the Commission issue an order approving the following proposed tariff sheets, as filed on July 27, 2007, to become effective on September 1, 2007, as requested by KCPL, or permit the tariff sheet to go into effect by operation-of-law:




