On September 8, 2011, the Commission's Staff ("Staff") filed a notice indicating that on September 6, 2011, it started its prudence audit of the fuel adjustment clause the Commission established for Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri ("Ameren"), in that company's last rate case, ER-2010-0036. The Commission held a hearing on June 21, 2012, and the case is submitted.

On May 14, 2013, The Missouri Court of Appeals issued its opinion in *State ex. rel. Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri v. Public Service Commission of the State of Missouri.*¹ The Court issued a mandate in that case on June 4, 2013.

The Commission will order the parties to state how the Commission should proceed in light of the above-mentioned opinion.

1. The parties shall respond as ordered above no later than June 21, 2013.
