ORDER GRANTING APPLICATION TO INTERVENE

On January 23, 2008, Kansas City Power & Light Company applied for a waiver or variance regarding the rates it may charge certain all-electric and electric heating customers. In response, the Commission issued notice of the filing and established February 13 as an intervention deadline. Praxair, Inc. applied to intervene on February 4. More than ten days have passed and no party has objected to Praxair's application to intervene.

The Commission finds that Praxair's interest in this case that differs from that of the general public and that Praxair's interest may be adversely affected by a final order arising from this case. Furthermore, the Commission finds that allowing Praxair to intervene will serve the public interest. Therefore, in accordance with Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.075(4), the Commission will grant Praxair's application to intervene.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. Praxair, Inc.'s Application to Intervene is granted.

2. This order shall become effective on February 15, 2008.
