ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE REBUTTAL TESTIMONY AND MODIFYING THE PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

On March 31, 2021, the Commission issued its order establishing a procedural schedule, which set April 30, 2021, as the deadline to file rebuttal testimony. On April 29, 2021, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri, filed a motion requesting that the deadline for it to file rebuttal testimony be extended to May 7, 2021. In support of its motion, Ameren Missouri states that it is in the process of investigating new allegations contained in Blodgett Paint Ball & Fun Factory LLC's amended application for a change of electric service provider.

Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-2.050(3), provides that when an act is required by Commission rule or order to be done within a specified time, the Commission may order the period enlarged before the expiration of the period originally prescribed.

Ameren Missouri represents that neither Blodgett Paint Ball & Fun Factory LLC nor SEMO Electric Cooperative object to an extension. Therefore, the Commission will grant the motion for an extension and modify the procedural schedule accordingly.

1. Ameren Missouri's motion for an extension of time is granted.
