## ORDER SETTING PREHEARING CONFERENCE

On January 11, 2006, Kansas City Power & Light Company and the United States Department of Energy, on behalf of the National Nuclear Security Administration, filed a Joint Application. That application requests that the Commission find that it is reasonable and prudent for KCPL to relocate and reconfigure a substation that serves DOE-NNSA.

The Staff of the Commission filed its Status Report on February 14. Staff stated that this case could not be resolved simply via a Staff Recommendation, and also asked the Commission to set a prehearing conference.

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.080(15) allows parties ten days to respond to pleadings. DOE-NNSA did not respond to Staff's request within ten days. Therefore, the Commission will take up Staff's motion unopposed. The Commission finds Staff's motion reasonable, and will grant it.

A prehearing conference is scheduled for this case on March 15, 2006, at
 10:00 a.m. The prehearing conference shall be held in Room 305 of the Governor Office
 Building, 200 Madison Street, Jefferson City, Missouri. The Governor Office Building meets

accessibility standards required by the Americans with Disabilities Act.
