NOTICE OF DEFICIENCY

Issue Date: February 26, 2021

On February 23, 2021, Cathect Communications Inc. filed an application for authorization to provide basic local exchange (CLEC) telecommunications services. Cathect Communications Inc.'s application is signed by Suzane Anderson, who is not identified as an attorney licensed to practice law in Missouri or any other state.

Missouri statute Section 484.020, RSMo (2016), restricts the practice of law to licensed attorneys, and Commission rules require corporations be represented by an attorney. Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-2.080(1) states that pleadings shall be signed by an attorney. Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-2.080(5) states that unsigned pleadings may be rejected. Lastly, Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-2.040(5), requires all entities be represented by counsel except when a natural person acting solely on his or her own behalf and representing only him or herself.¹

Cathect Communications Inc.'s application is signed by Ms. Anderson, who is not identified as an attorney. To appear before the Commission, Cathect Communications Inc., which appears to be a corporate entity, must be represented by an attorney authorized to practice law in Missouri.

Therefore, the application is deficient in that it does not comply with Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-2.040 requiring a corporation to be represented by counsel. The Commission cannot take action on this complaint until this deficiency is corrected. The Commission will leave the file open until March 18, 2021, to allow Cathect Communications Inc. to correct the deficiency. If no response is filed by that time, the Commission will reject the filing and close the file.
