On July 31, 2013¹, the Commission issued its Report and Order. Union Electric Company, d/b/a Ameren Missouri, filed an Application for Rehearing on August 22.

Section 386.500.1, RSMo (2000), provides that the Commission shall grant an application for rehearing if “in its judgment sufficient reason therefor be made to appear.” The Commission finds that the applicant failed to establish sufficient reason to grant the application. The Commission will deny it.
