Union Electric Company, d/b/a Ameren Missouri filed its 2011 Integrated Resource Plan (IRP) on February 23, 2011. Following the procedure established by the Commission's rules, Staff, Public Counsel, and various intervenors have identified what they believe are deficiencies in Ameren Missouri's IRP. After engaging in negotiations, the parties have been unable to resolve their differences and Ameren Missouri has filed its formal response to those alleged deficiencies.

The Commission Rule under which Ameren Missouri submitted its IRP provides that the Commission will "issue an order which indicates on what items, if any, a hearing will be held and which establishes a procedural schedule." To assist the Commission in determining how to proceed, the Commission will schedule a conference.

1. A conference is scheduled for September 12, 2011, at 10:00 a.m., at the Commission's office at the Governor Office Building, 200 Madison Street, Jefferson City, Missouri, Room 305.
