4	Q	PLEASE STATE YOUR NAME.
5	А	My name is Michael Duffy.
6	Q	ON WHOSE BEHALF ARE YOU APPEARING FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS
7		DIRECT TESTIMONY?
8	А	I am appearing for purposes of this testimony on behalf of intervenor City of Riverside (the
9		"City"). The City receives service directly and its residents also receive service from
10		Missouri-American Water Company ("MAWC").
11	Q	PLEASE DESCRIBE YOUR EMPLOYMENT.
12	А	I am Director of Community Development for the City.
13	Q	WHAT IS YOUR INTEREST IN THIS PARTICULAR CASE?
14	А	I am testifying as a representative of the City, which is attempting to protect its citizens in
15		the present case. The City is within the Parkville District, subject to the Platte County water
16		tariff at issue in this case.
17	Q	WHAT IS THE PURPOSE OF YOUR TESTIMONY?
18	А	The purpose of my testimony is to describe certain issues with respect to the rate design and
19		proposed rate increases by MAWC in the Parkville District.
20	Q	WHAT IS THE CITY'S POSITION REGARDING THE RATE DESIGN IN THE

21 **PARKVILLE DISTRICT?**

A The City would like to express its appreciation that MAWC has proposed to maintain a
 uniform declining block rate structure for the Parkville District. We believe that maintaining
 this rate structure reasonably reflects cost and minimizes the impact on the City's citizens.

WHAT IS THE CITY'S POSITION REGARDING MAWC'S PROPOSED RATE

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INCREASES FOR THE PARKVILLE DISTRICT?

6 A While the City supports the cost-based uniform declining block rate structure that MAWC 7 proposes to maintain, we believe that MAWC's proposed rate increases of approximately 8 36% for the monthly minimum meter charges are disproportionately large when compared to 9 the percentage increases for other charges (e.g., there are proposed rate increases of 10 approximately 25.7% for volumetric charges). We believe that such large and 11 disproportionate rate increases are inappropriate, especially in the current economic 12 environment.

13 Q BASED ON THE FOREGOING, WHAT RELIEF ARE YOU REQUESTING IN 14 RELATION TO THESE ISSUES?

15 A The City requests that any rate increases be made on a uniform percentage basis (e.g., the 16 percentage increase for the monthly minimum meter charges should be equal to the 17 percentage increase for volumetric charges, etc.), and that the Commission take such action 18 as is necessary and reasonable to limit the amount of any increase in the monthly minimum 19 meter charges, taking into consideration the current economic environment. We believe that 20 limiting MAWC's proposed rate increases in this manner will help to maintain and preserve 21 the current rate design for the Parkville District, which we believe is just and reasonable.

22 Q DOES THAT CONCLUDE YOUR TESTIMONY?

23 A Yes.
